**CIRCULAR FOR PARENTS**

May 14, 2020

The Hon'ble Division Bench of the High Court of Delhi presided by the Chief Justice has passed a Judgment dated 24.04.2020 in **W.P.(C) 2993/2020** titled as "**Naresh Kumar vs. Directorate of Education**" wherein the Petitioner's prayer seeking exemption from payment of Tuition Fees during the period of the Lockdown was rejected. The Hon'ble High Court further endorsed the Judgment passed by the Ld. Single Judge in WP (C) 2977/2020 titled as "**Rajat Vats v. GNCTD**" wherein it was held that:

- “7. *Insofar as the tuition fee is concerned, the charging of the same would be justified in view of the fact that almost all the schools are conducting online classes and teachers are discharging their functions by imparting course work over online platforms, checking project work online, correcting papers wherein students have already given examinations, preparing questions and lessons taught and supervising students to complete the work given etc. There is also a burden on the schools to pay their staff during these months.*
8. *The authorities having taken cognisance of the issue and further the matter being one in the policy domain, this Court is not inclined to interfere.”*

In view of the above direction passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi we request you to remit the Tuition Fee for the month of April 2020 and onwards which is due from you. The same is in the spirit of the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court. It is also requested that the arrears of Fee due prior to the lockdown, be cleared at the earliest by cheque and/or online payment to the school account.
